

“March on the Boss” Checklist

On Tuesday, February 13, SEIU Local 99 members across the district will take action by leading a “march on the boss” at their school or worksite. This is the same day that members will be attending the LAUSD School Board meeting to make our demands known directly to the school board and Superintendent Carvalho. To ensure we have a successful, coordinated action, follow this checklist:

- Have at least 80% of classified employees at your school/worksite commit to standing together for livable wages, more hours & more staffing. You can calculate 80% using this formula: Total classified school employees at your school _____ x 0.8 = _____
 - Classified school employees include: Teacher Assistants, Instructional Aides, Special Education Assistants, Community Reps, Campus Aides, Supervision Aides, Food Service Workers, Buildings and Grounds Workers, Bus Drivers, Early Education Center Aide, After/Before-School Program Support Workers, and much more.

- Identify at least 3 members willing to represent workers at your school/worksite and deliver the petition to the Principal/Administrator. List their names and contact info here:

- Identify the best time & date to get together during a break/lunch/before or after school. Best Practice: schedule an appointment with the Principal. Let them know you would like to relay a message from SEIU Local 99 classified school employees at your school.

- Take pictures and/or videos of members “Marching on the Boss”
 - Make sure to avoid children in the pictures/videos

- The day before you present the petition, create a group chat to remind members to wear purple and/or buttons on the day of the action. You can use Whatsapp, Signal, GroupMe, FB Messenger, or other group chat apps.
